Set time aside for your revision. Have a designated quiet space where you can easily concentrate. Make a revision timetable. Use the QR code to find out how to do this.



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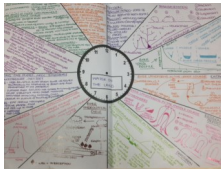
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## Find the right method...
