Sessions will cover:

- Building resilience through encouraging self-efficacy in feedback strategies - how do we get pupils to use their metacognitive skills to 'get' the feedback, what it means and how to use it to improve?
- Knowledge organisers, learning lists and success criteria in feedback to pupils - how do we empower pupils to use feedback to improve including those with SEND and our lower achieving pupils?
- Staff wellbeing - how can we safeguard wellbeing but still ensure good progress through marking and feedback?
- There will also be time to share our marking and feedback policies and whole school strategies for feedback.
